Join us for the 1st annual Artisans In The Park Summer Fest at the Ephrata Cloister which will be held on Saturday, June 29, 2019 from 9am – 4pm. This event is held the fourth Saturday in June every year at 632 West Main Street, Ephrata, PA 17522 which is located off Route 322, at the historical Ephrata Cloister, less than one hour from Hershey, Harrisburg, Kutztown, Reading, Lancaster, Lititz West Chester and York.

The space fee is \$100 per 10’x10’ and you must provide your own tent/canopy, tables, table cloths and chairs. There is a \$25 discount for each additional space (2 spaces = \$175). If you require more than one space, please indicate that below. Please email me directly with any other set-up/space requests or questions.

Set up can be done Friday starting at noon (there is overnight security) thru Saturday, but must be complete by 8:30am on Saturday. The show begins promptly at 9am. The show concludes at 4pm and is held rain or shine. All vendors are expected to stay the length of the show and there are no refunds for cancellations. There is easy unloading and loading and vendor parking in close proximity. For safety reasons, no vehicles are permitted in show areas from 8:30am-4:10pm.

Spaces are filled on a first come, first serve basis and there is a limit on the number of artists per category/medium. Artists may only bring/sell the items that they have listed on their application and all items must be handmade/handconstructed. There is no buy/resell or independent consultants permitted for this event. If you specialize in more than one art category/medium, you must list all of the art categories/mediums that you will be representing/selling during the event. If the art category/medium that you specialize in is already being fully represented, I will contact you to return your show fee and discuss our waiting list options.

Vendor covenants that it will protect, defend, hold harmless and indemnify the Friend’s of the Conrad Weiser Homestead, Artisans In The Park Organization, Inc, and the Conrad Weiser Homestead, their directors, officers, agents, employees, and volunteers from and against any and all expenses, claims, actions, liabilities, attorney’s fees, damages, and losses of any kind whatsoever, actually or allegedly, resulting from or connected with the participation as a Vendor in the event.

If you are interested in participating in this annual show, please return the completed application below along with your payment by April 27, 2019. There is a \$15 late application fee for any applications received after the deadline. Spaces will not be reserved without both an application and payment. No applications will be accepted after June 8, 2019. Please either email or include with your application a picture(s) of your work and a short bio. Applications will not be accepted until your bio and pictures are received. Your picture(s) and bio may be used for advertising purposes.
